



### **Enrollment in Electronic Education Courses**

1. No J.D. student or student in the LL.M. in International Law program may take more than 4 credit hours in any term, nor more than 12 total credit hours of electronic education courses toward the degree.
2. No J.D. student or student in the LL.M. in International Law program will be allowed to enroll in any electronic education course until he or she has successfully completed 28 credit hours. Transfer credits may be used to reach the 28 credit hour requirement. Additionally, transient students who have completed 28 credit hours at their home institution may take an electronic education course with their home school's permission.
