



Policy on Special Accommodations for Foreign Students

Stetson College of Law encourages applicants from other countries in the interest of promoting a racially, ethnically and culturally diverse academic environment. All students admitted to Stetson are expected to be fluent in the English language. However, the following accommodation is available to qualified foreign students to assist them in adjusting to the rigors of law study in the United States.

A foreign student may receive fifty percent (50%) additional time on exams in those required course which are regularly scheduled during the first three semesters, provided the student is from a non-English speaking country and request the accommodation from the Registrar at least thirty (30) days prior to the examination, and has not lived in the United States for more than five (5) years. Special exceptions may be made to the five-year limitation by the Associate Dean on good cause shown by the student, and shall be reported to the Faculty.
